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Convicted Offender/Arrestee DNA Backlog Reduction Program Purpose

- Accelerate the analysis of convicted offender and arrestee samples collected by States in order to provide CODIS-compatible data for all 13 CODIS core STR loci for local, State, and national DNA databases
- Ensure that law enforcement is provided with critical investigative information in a timely manner.
- Upload all convicted offender DNA profiles obtained with funding from this announcement to the Combined DNA Index System (CODIS) and the National DNA Index System (NDIS).

Non-competitive award

Funds awarded based on the estimated number of database samples awaiting analysis as of March 31, 2010, that are not able to be worked using State funds

Award amounts (in-house and outsourced analysis): \$35.00 per profile generated <u>\$5.00 per profile for data review</u> \$40.00 total per sample analyzed and uploaded



Convicted Offender/Arrestee DNA Backlog Reduction Program Information

Eligibility

- Lab must be accredited by a nonprofit, professional, nationally recognized association actively involved in forensic science
- Lab must undergo an external DNA audit every two years
- Lab must be an NDIS participant
- Must be able to analyze at least 50 % of their annual receipt of CO or arrestee DNA samples or a minimum of 5,000 CO or arrestee DNA samples per month (if applying for funds for in-house analysis)


