FIDO Program Benefits

- The FIDO Program has the possibility of providing immediate investigative information without the need for extensive laboratory analysis
- FIDO Program can facilitate case adjudication in preliminary phases to include plea bargain and/or pre-arraignment
- FIDO Program can provide guidance for laboratory submission of presumptive test evidence for trial analysis
